No-smoking Policy

Policy statement

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage in making our setting a no-smoking environment - both indoors and outdoors. Procedures

- We actively encourage no-smoking by having information for parents and staff about where to get help to stop smoking if they are seeking this information.
- Currently all members of staff are non-smokers.
